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"Early on in producing 'DAVID,' we started to feel as if we were ahead of our timeline," said Show Producer Ryan Miller. "And then, the pandemic happened and the whole theater shut down. Suddenly this very collaborative process that we relied on came to an abrupt stop. Yet, God had placed a passion in our hearts for this story and we trusted that He would help us bring this production to completion."

In the wake of the shutdown, Sight & Sound's leadership decided that even without employees on-site, they were going to move forward with the production timeline of "DAVID." Miller and a small group of key players worked on the story independently for a few months until the full team was able to be back creating together.

"I was overjoyed when our dynamic team finally returned and was able to collaborate on this production," said Josh Enck, President and CSO of Sight & Sound. "God brought us through yet another trial and once again proved his faithfulness – which is what we see reflected beautifully in David's story."

The production of "DAVID" will freshly present the familiar Bible story when it premieres on Sight & Sound's 300-foot panoramic stage in Lancaster, Pennsylvania with giant sets, unbelievable special effects and original music inspired by the Psalms. Additionally, theater attendees are in for a surprise at the reveal of Goliath, one of the most complicated special effects Sight & Sound has ever designed.

"This show will break down the complexities of who David truly was," said Sight & Sound Director Marketing and Communications Katie Miller. "We know he was a shepherd, a warrior, a poet, and a king. We're excited to take audiences inside his struggles and triumphs as we come to know the man who is remembered, most importantly, as a man after God's own heart."

Katie is a member of the Brand Development team, bringing alignment to each of the brand's extensions through marketing, advertising, public relations and corporate communications. Katie continues to connect Sight & Sound's past to its future, introducing audience members from around the world to the Sight & Sound story. Katie and her husband, Brian, reside in Lancaster, Pennsylvania, raising their three children-now fourth-generation family members acting on the Sight & Sound stage.



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<u>Sight & Sound</u>® is a ministry on a mission to bring the Bible to life through live theater, television and film. What started more than 45 years ago as a traveling multimedia show has today become a destination for over 25 million people.

Founded by Shirley and Glenn Eshelman in 1976, Sight & Sound was inspired by a paintbrush and a prayer. Both raised on Lancaster County farms, it was Glenn who developed a love for painting and photographing scenic landscapes. He received an invitation to present his photography at a local church and, using a slide projector, a turntable for musical underscore and a microphone for narration, the audience response was overwhelming. This first unofficial "Sight & Sound" show became a humble success.

By the mid-1970's, Glenn and Shirley were taking their multimedia presentations to audiences around the U.S. Its popularity gave way to a permanent home for their productions, and in 1976, the Living Waters Theatre opened for business. It was here that Sight & Sound Theatres was born.

Over time, more live theatrical elements were added to the shows, and in 1987, the first complete, full-length biblical production debuted: "Behold the Lamb." In just a few short years, they outgrew the Living Waters Theatre and the realization of a new dream began: a larger, better-equipped facility on a plot of land just across the cornfield. In 1991, the Entertainment Centre opened to rave reviews.

Sadly, in 1997 the six-year-old Entertainment Centre was destroyed by a fire. Glenn and Shirley would not give up on their vision, however. Just 18 months later, the construction of a new building was complete. This new 2,000-seat, state-of-the-art theater featured a massive, 300-foot panoramic stage that wrapped around the audience, with the ability to house sets four stories tall. The first show to take the stage was Sight & Sound's signature production — "NOAH." Audiences gasped as they were immersed in a spectacular ark full of animals that surrounded them on three sides.

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By the early 2000's, sell-out crowds sparked a new idea from Glenn and Shirley: what would it look like for Sight & Sound Theatres to expand? Their vision to open a second location was finally realized in 2008, when the nearly identical twin theater opened in the beautiful Ozark Mountains of Branson, Missouri.

Today, with a decade of operating two theaters, producing and premiering a brand-new show every other year and designing each production to travel between Lancaster and Branson, Sight & Sound is slowly honing its craft of taking the most powerful stories from the pages of Scripture and bringing them to life on stage.

What began with a few slide projectors, a passion for creativity and a desire to serve God, grew into the Sight & Sound Theatres we know today—the nation's largest organization of its kind, and one of the top three theater destinations in the country. The company remains a family-owned business, led by the next generation of the Eshelman family with a passionately committed team of 600 employees.
