Global Church Network's 'Synergize 2024' Conference to Gather Christian Leaders from Every World Region

Biennial Event Unites the Global Church for the Fulfillment of the Great Commission by 2030

ORLANDO, Jan. 17, 2024 — With the goal of equipping, networking and mobilizing one million new ministers to help fulfill the Great Commission, Global Church Network's [Synergize 2024](#) will take place February 14-16, 2024, in Orlando, Florida, drawing more than 800 pastors and leaders from 80 nations and every world region.

A biennial event, "Synergize" is designed for Christian leaders who desire to network, synergize and mobilize for the fulfillment of the Great Commission. Since its inception in 2002, the conference has drawn more than 55,000 Christian leaders from more than 100 nations representing 100 denominations.

"Synergize 2024 is where the Church comes together to help save the world," said founder and president of Global Church Network (GCN), Dr. James O. Davis. "General Superintendents, General Overseers, Pastors and evangelistic leaders who want to go beyond just 'doing church' can instead embark on a Christian ministry adventure that will impact their entire community and every nation."

The three-day event will feature 25 renowned plenary speakers sharing powerful messages related to the Synergize 2024 theme of "The Unhindered Gospel" — a reference to the last verse of the book of Acts which says the Gospel was shared "with all boldness and without hindrance!" Five major sessions will challenge attendees to be unhindered in their mind, management, marriage, missions and ministry.

"Why would we withhold the cure, when people around us are ill?" asked Dr. Carla Sunberg, General Superintendent of the Church of the Nazarene. "Let us unite to bring the healing power of Jesus to every nation. Synergize has been the place where I have found brothers and sisters from across many different churches and denominations who are ready to link arms."

The conference will offer 18 engaging breakout sessions led by distinguished faith experts addressing best practices related to modern evangelism, prayer, missions, technology in ministry and leadership development.

Synergize 2024 will highlight remaining priorities for **FINISH: 2030**, GCN's strategic mandate to mobilize 1 million new ministers to help fulfill the Great Commission by the 2,000th anniversary of the founding of the Church.

"I have spoken at every Synergize Conference since 2010," said Dr. Timothy Hill, General Overseer of the Church of God, Cleveland, TN. "Dr. Davis and I have traveled the world together focused on synergizing the Body of Christ. I believe Synergize 2024 attendees will witness firsthand a faith-filled focus on FINISH: 2030."

GLOBAL CHURCH NETWORK

During his years serving as an evangelist, Dr. James O. Davis, president of [Global Church Network](#) (GCN), formerly known as Billion Soul Network, learned that more than 90% of pastors worldwide have no formal education. Burdened by the lack of ministry training among teachers and pastors, in 2001 he shared his vision with the late Dr. Bill Bright, founder of Campus Crusade (now Cru), with whom he co-founded the organization that has since gone on to impact millions of people across the world. In August of that year, they announced before the Assemblies of God General Presbytery their ambitious mission to help plant five million new churches around the world with the goal of saving one billion souls.

GCN equips pastors and church leaders from around the world for outreach in their surrounding communities by holding its international, biennial Synergize conference and annual leadership summits, which have been attended by more than 85,000 individuals.

Since 2002, GCN has helped train tens of thousands of Christian leaders worldwide through the [Global Church Divinity School](#) (GCDS). Offering seven powerful ministry tracks, the GCDS online campus houses more than 250 interactive training courses in the Global Church Classroom, taught by renowned Christian leaders from every world region and every major denomination. Hundreds of additional training materials are available in the Global Church Library, the international resource bank of the finest Christian books, video, audio and articles in the world. Dr. Elmer Towns, Co-Founder of Liberty University serves as the Dean of the GCDS.

In 2012, GCN launched the Global Hubs of Christianity. Today, there are more than 160 Hubs, scaling to 800 Hubs by 2030. Every Hub synergizes the best relationships, systematizes the best training and strategizes for unreached people groups. Over two years, pastors and leaders meet every six months for training in leadership development, church planting, visionary networking, evangelism/discipleship and global missions. Upon the completion of the training, they graduate, and the Mother Hub multiplies in each nation.

Additionally, local churches from around the world have joined GCN as a Billion Soul™ Church.

A Billion Soul Church is a Bible-believing, Christ-centered, spirit-filled, Kingdom-minded and mission-sending church that is characterized with prayer, passion for souls, discipling peoples, visionary leadership, sacrificial giving, and commitment to fulfill the Great Commission.

A Billion Soul™ Church is:

- A synergizing Church that networks and partners with others to complete the Great Commission;
- A soul-Saving Church with a focus on doubling in size within ten to fifteen years;
- A seeking Church that prays for the Great Commission to be fulfilled;
- A sending Church that trains ministers to send into the harvest field and plants churches;
- A sowing Church that invests resources and finances into GCN.

GCN includes more than 2,750 denominations and 700,000 churches and has reached its founding milestone of bringing one billion individuals to salvation and helping to plant five million churches. Going forward, the GCN's missional goal is to help fulfill the Great Commission by the 2,000th anniversary of the Christian church in 2030 through the [FINISH:2030](#) initiative.

On February 15, 2024, in the heart of Synergize 2024, GCN will launch Jerusalem 2030, scheduled to convene at the International Convention Center of Jerusalem on June 9-11, 2030. Three thousand leaders will be invited in honor of the first three thousand who came to Christ when Peter preached his first sermon at the First Pentecost, consummating the birth of the Church.

DR. JAMES O. DAVIS - long version bio

Dr. James O. Davis is the founder of Cutting Edge International and Global Church Network, a growing coalition of more than 2,750 Christian ministries and denominations from around the world who are synergizing and mobilizing their efforts to build a premier global community of pastors to help finish the Great Commission by the 2,000th Birthday of the Church (Finish2030.com). With more than 700,000 churches represented, the Global Church Network has become the largest pastors' network in the world.

Christian leaders recognize Dr. Davis as one of the leading networkers in the Christian world. More than 85,000 pastors and leaders have attended his biennial pastors' conference and leadership summits across the United States and in all major world regions. Dr. Davis has been named among the "Top Ten Christian Influencers in the World."

From 1997 to 2000, Dr. Davis served on the Amsterdam 2000 Executive Committee with the late Dr. Billy Graham and the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association. Amsterdam 2000 hosted more than 11,000 leaders from 217 nations, provinces and territories. The main focus of Amsterdam 2000 was to ascertain where the gospel is not and to mobilize evangelistic leaders to help complete the Great Commission.

In October 2017, Dr. Davis spearheaded and hosted The Wittenberg 2017 Congress in Berlin, Germany. The Wittenberg 2017 Congress celebrated the 500th anniversary of Martin Luther nailing his 95 Theses on the Castle Church door in Wittenberg, Germany. This historic congress brought together more than 600 influential leaders from more than 80 denominations and every world region. Finish 2030 was launched at the gravesite of Martin Luther, the Protestant Reformer.

In September 2005, the Global Church Network launched the Billion Soul Initiative in Dallas, Texas. The overarching goal established was the planting of five million churches for a billion-soul harvest in 10 to 15 years. In October and November 2019, GCN achieved the goals of one billion souls saved and five million new churches planted respectively.

Dr. Davis served 12 years as the National Evangelists Representative at the Assemblies of God World Headquarters, leading 1,500 evangelists and training thousands of students for full-time evangelism. Ministering more than 45 weeks per year for the last 40 years, Dr. Davis has now traveled over ten million miles to minister face-to-face to millions of people in nearly 140 nations.

Dr. Davis earned a Doctorate in Ministry in Preaching at Trinity Evangelical Divinity School and two master's degrees from the Assemblies of God Theological Seminary

As a part of the international Body of Christ representing different church organizations around the world, Global Church Network (GCN) (formerly the Billion Soul movement) recognizes its role and responsibility in fulfilling the Great Commission. GCN believes that every church, regardless of its size, and every Christian, whether known or unknown, can add value to the entire Body of Christ.

For nearly 20 years, GCN has synergistically partnered with thousands of organizations and more than 700,000 churches, spanning virtually every denomination and world region. In 2017, they added a finish line: 2030 — the 2,000th birthday of the Church.

Referred to as **FINISH 2030**, the collaboration offers a new overarching strategy for pursuing the Great Commission — one that is synergistic, global in scope and capable of outpacing population growth and getting the Church to the finish line sooner than we ever dreamed possible.

In this endeavor, GCN has committed to carrying out this calling through the following **F.I.N.I.S.H.** objectives:

Find the remaining unreached people groups around the world and engage them through denominational and organizational platforms for the purposes of cultural understanding, missional strategies, Bible translation, evangelism, church planting and discipleship. The National Church will be challenged to translate the Bible into every remaining language and place a missionary presence in the unreached communities;

Intercede throughout the entire body of Christ for harmony in the Church, humility before Christ, healing of the sick and harvest of the lost;

Network for the synergizing and mobilizing of the entire body of Christ toward the fulfillment of the Great Commission;

Invest time, thoughts, talents, temples and treasures into unengaged, unreached people groups and into the Kingdom of God worldwide;

Send equipped missionaries not only to regions where the Gospel is, but into regions where it is not in order to consistently move toward the finish line; and

Harvest together until the last person has heard the saving Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Throughout this decade, Christians from around the world are encouraged to join GCN in fulfilling the Great Commission through FINISH 2030 and by offering prayer support.
